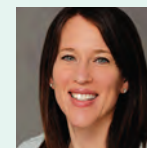
community—the Board of Trustees, students, faculty, staff, family members and neighbors—for a joyous groundbreaking ceremony.

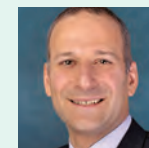

DISCOVERY ACROSS CULTURES AND DISCIPLINES

Bernard Zell 8th graders are integrating art, history, reading, writing and technology in a unique and eye-opening year-long project. They collaborated with a high school in Poland to develop a graphic novel that describes the Warsaw Uprising from different perspectives. The *Resistance Project* tells the story of Mark Edelman, a resistance fighter in the Warsaw Ghetto Uprising and a heroic figure to both Jews and non-Jewish Poles, and that of a Polish poet and resistance figure, bridging their experiences and that of the students’.

The students are learning the art of the graphic novel from artist-in-residence Ken Krimstein, political cartoonist at The New Yorker magazine and author of *The Three Escapes of Hannah Arendt*. The students are also learning to apply digital storytelling skills, including augmented reality development, to the *Resistance Project*.

This innovative, creative and in-depth exploration of humanities will help students prepare for secondary studies and beyond, growing their research and literacy skills, as well as their cultural empathy and understanding.



8th-grade students learn and practice their digital storytelling skills and apply them to projects in their humanities classes.



In an integrated tech class, 8th-grade students are learning digital storytelling skills. To begin, students created a storyboard and produced a short video for their personal stories in writing class. Using the CoSpaces platform, students designed characters coded to speak, act and move; recorded a script in Hebrew and translated it in English captions; and connected scenes using coding. Students further developed their digital storytelling techniques using Unity, a cross-platform game engine, with which they added augmented reality to their *Resistance Project* in history class. Finally, students brought these skills together to create an interactive landscape about a novel from reading class for the OculusGo virtual reality headset.

These tech platforms inspire creativity and give students a new way to experience literature and, at the same time, build their digital literacy with the latest tools.



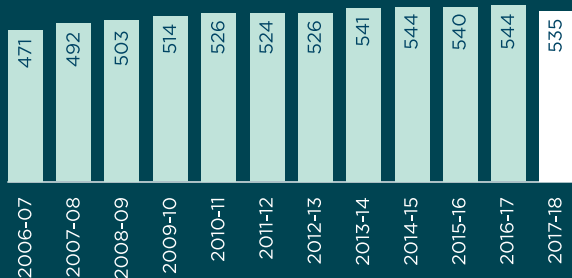

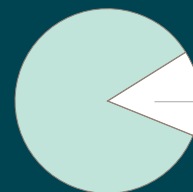

FINANCIAL UPDATE 2018

We thank our community as Annual Campaign and fundraising revenues continued to generate significant levels of support during the 2017-2018 school year. Nearly \$1.5 million was raised, covering nearly 8.5% of our operating budget of approximately \$17.5 million. After incorporating support from other revenue sources, expenses exceeded net revenue by a little over \$1 million. If we were to include capital contributions to fund the Campaign for Bernard Zell, the addition to net assets would total nearly \$7.8 million. The Bernard Zell Board of Trustees, Finance Committee, and Administration will continue to focus on sound financial management, especially in light of the capital project and the upcoming physical transformation of the school.

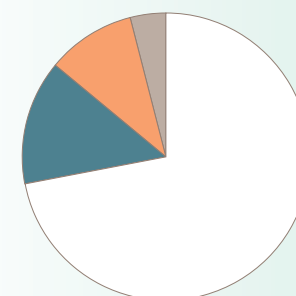

CHANGE IN NET ASSETS (excluding Capital Project activity)

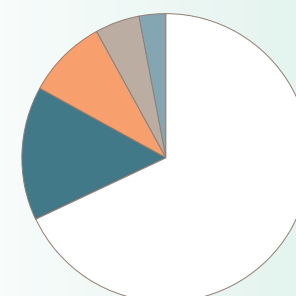

The campaign to Transform Bernard Zell has raised over \$17.7 million to date to renovate and expand our current school building. The expansion efforts have begun, and we plan to open the doors of the new building in Fall 2019. This campaign is more than just an expansion of physical space, it is an investment and a commitment to the Jewish community of Chicago to develop future change-makers and trailblazers.
